BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Irvington, County of Essex, State of New Jersey.

That pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-8(e) the following described locations are deleted as bus stops:

County Road

1. Deleted:

Along Springfield Avenue, eastbound, on the southerly side thereof at:

a. Bruen Avenue – Near Side

Beginning at the easterly curb line of Bruen Avenue and extending 105 feet easterly therefrom

b. Grove Street – Near Side

Beginning at the easterly curb line of Grove Street and extending 105 feet easterly therefrom

c. Avon Avenue – Near Side

Beginning at the easterly curb line of Avon Avenue and extending 105 feet easterly therefrom

Along Springfield Avenue, westbound, on the northerly side thereof at:

a. South 21st Street – Near Side

Beginning at the easterly curb line of South 21st Street and extending 105 feet easterly therefrom

b. Bruen Avenue – Far Side

Beginning at the westerly curb line of Bruen Avenue and extending 105 feet Westerly therefrom

That the Mayor and Council of Irvington Township will enforce the needed traffic regulations governing the aforementioned bus stop locations and provide the necessary police security to ensure the safety of the traveling public.
