WHEREAS, the total amount of the emergency appropriations created, including the appropriation to be created by this resolution is \$1,629,159.87 and three (3) percent of the total operating appropriations in the budget for 2018 is \$2,612,725.48.; and

WHEREAS, the foregoing appropriation together with prior appropriations does not exceed three (3) percent of the total operating appropriations in the budget for 2019,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, (by not less than 2/3 of all governing body members affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with NJS 40A:4-48:

1. An emergency appropriation is here by made for the following:

a. Police S & W / Overtime	\$1,276,300.61
b. Sewer Collapse	352,859.26
TOTAL	\$1,629,159.87

2. The said emergency appropriation shall be provided for in full in the 2020 budget, and is requested to be excluded from CAPS, pursuant to NJS 40A:4-53.3c(1).
