- ❑ **Use a Notebook**
- ❑ Write down any of your observations (suspicious persons, vehicle, activity)
- ❑ Descriptions
 - **Plate Number**
 - **Color of vehicle**
 - **Description of Vehicle**
 - **Description of Individual(s)**
 - **Complexion, Hight, Weight**
 - **Color of clothing (any distinctive marks, scars, tattoos)**
- ❑ Locations
- ❑ Time of Day
- ❑ How often do you see this happening
- ❑ What are they doing?
 - **Drug activity from Vehicle to Vehicle**
 - **Corner-hand to hand transaction**
 - **Drug Activity coming from a Residence**

COMMON SUSPICIOUS ACTIVITIES

- ❑ When a person or vehicle stays in the same location for a long or unusual period of time
- ❑ A person who behaves strangely or whose movements are unusual
- ❑ A vehicle (car, van, truck, etc.) frequently driving around your block or within a specific area.
- ❑ People carrying, concealing or attempting to conceal something suspicious
- ❑ A person who stops people on the street
- ❑ A person looking into cars and /or moving from car to car
- ❑ Groups of young people gathering wearing gang colors, not known to the neighborhood
